

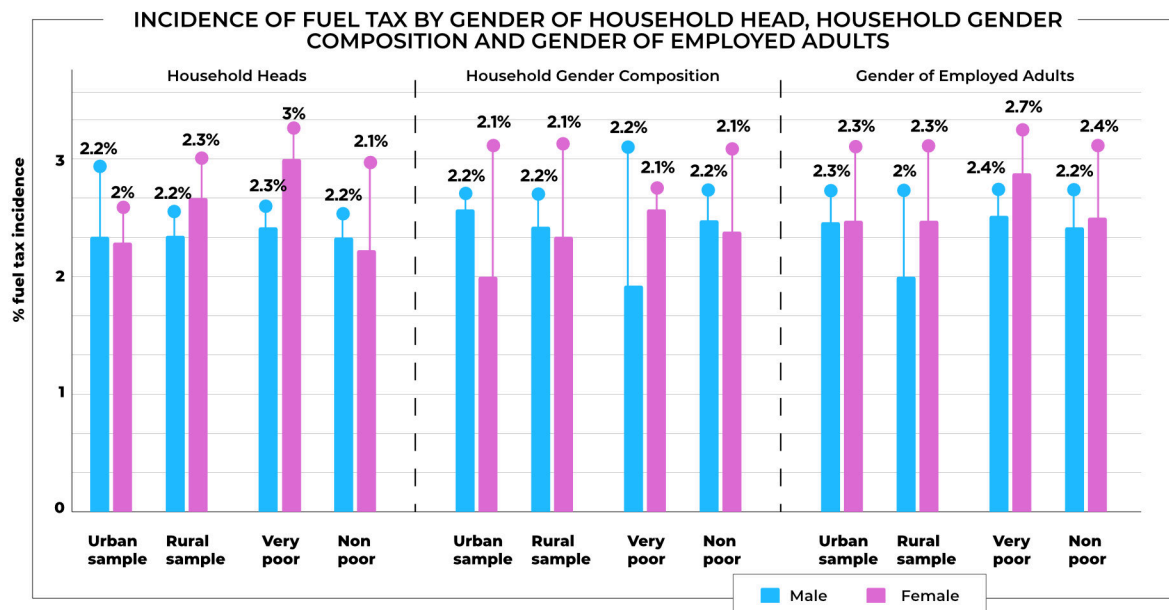

GENDER ANALYSIS OF GHANA'S TAX SYSTEM



HOW FUEL LEVIES IMPACT WOMEN VS. MEN



KEY POINTS

Higher Impact on Female-Headed Very Poor Households: Female-headed very poor households faced a 3% incidence of total indirect tax on fuel, which is 0.7 percentage points higher than that of male-headed households, indicating greater vulnerability among women in low-income brackets.

Higher Fuel Tax Incidence in Male-Adult Households: A generally higher fuel tax incidence was observed among households with more male adults (except among very poor households)
