



This notwithstanding, a report by the Ghana Revenue Authority (GRA) shows that apart from 2018 and 2019 fiscal years, the tax revenue targets for the period 2017-2022 were achieved. In the last five years, the most impressive performance was recorded in 2022 - i.e., the total tax revenue (GH₵75,706.34 million) exceeded its target (GH₵ 71,948.76); representing 31.8% growth (GRA, 2022)
